BREST HARBOURS WAITING LIST TERMS

Registration :

- People wishing to register on the waiting list must pay a fee of 15€ per harbour and per year.
- Entries on the waiting list are listed in chronological order and in the category corresponding to the length overall of the boat mentioned.
- There are :
 - 7 categories at the Château Marina (- de 6m / 6,01m to 7,50m / 7,51m to 9m / 9,01m to 10,50m / 10,51m to 12m / 12,01m to 13,50m / 13,51m and above)
 - 4 categories at the Moulin-Blanc Blanc (- de 6m / 6 to 8,99m / 9 to 10,19m / 10,20m to 12,49m).
- Registration can only be made in one category. If the length of the vessel is changed, the entry is reclassified in the corresponding category on the original date.
- The waiting list can be consulted at the port office. It is also possible to know the rank by a simple phone call.

Allocation :

- Allocations are made in the chronological order of the registration, according to available berths and their compatibility with the registered boat.
- All new boats arriving at the harbour will be measured by the harbour staff. In the event of a discrepancy with the information previously provided, a second measurement will be carried out in the presence of the customer, who acknowledges that he does not dispute the conclusions reached jointly.
- We recommend our customers to give us all their contact details (phone number, email address, etc.) and **to inform us of any changes**.
- The customer will be given a maximum of 3 days to answer to a berth proposal. After this deadline, the berth is proposed to the next person on the list and constitutes a non-response for us. However, the customer will keep his initial rank and will be contacted again at the next availability.

Additional informations :

- Waiting list registrations will be confirmed annually. Any request for cancellation of registration must be addressed to the harbour office in writing.
- **After 3 refusals or non-responses** to a berth proposal, on both harbours combined, the customer will be automatically removed from the lists and will then receive a letter informing him of this.
